Travel Visas

It may take Canadian Embassies/Consulates several months to process a visa application. Applicants must check with their respective authorities to determine exact processing requirements. Letters of Invitation for Travel Visa Applications

Upon request, the Canadian Radiation Protection Association (CRPA) will issue a Letter of Invitation to international delegates who require a travel visa to enter Canada to attend the conference. **CRPA does not issue Letters of Invitation for groups - letters are issued for individuals only.**

- CRPA does not accept any responsibility for visa applications nor will it influence the processing of visas.
- CRPA does not cover expenses related to conference attendance. Costs for conference registration, travel, accommodation, transportation, and meals not included with conference registration are the responsibility of the delegate.
- If a delegate is unable to attend the conference due to being unable to obtain a visa, a refund for conference registration fees will be issued upon request, in accordance with the Refund Policy as outlined on the [conference website](#).
